3. Write the letter name inside the note.

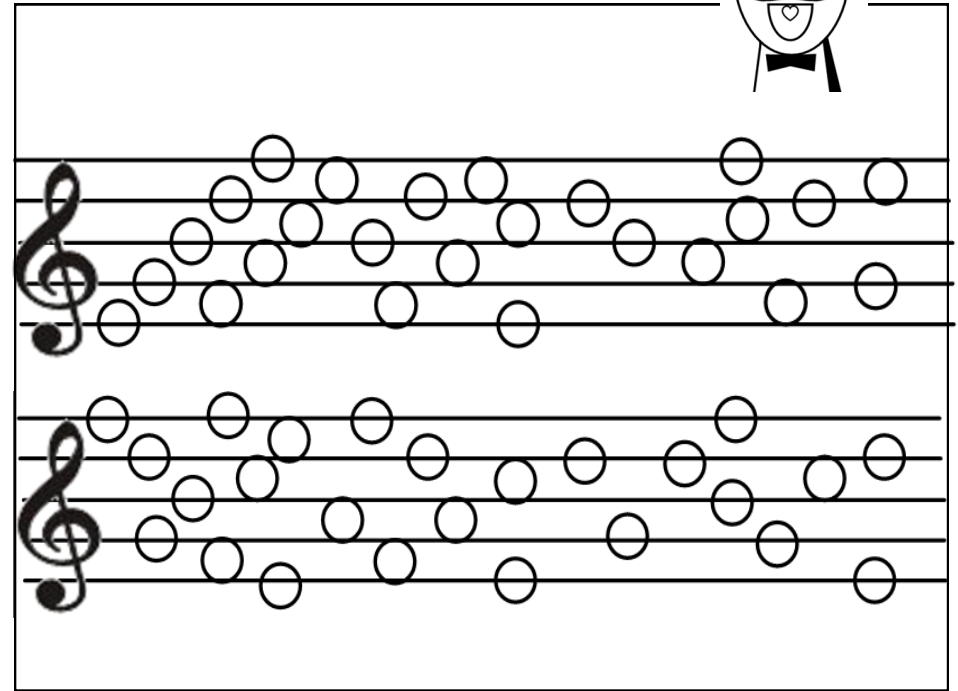
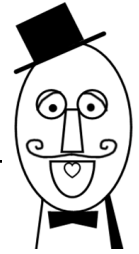
Tips:

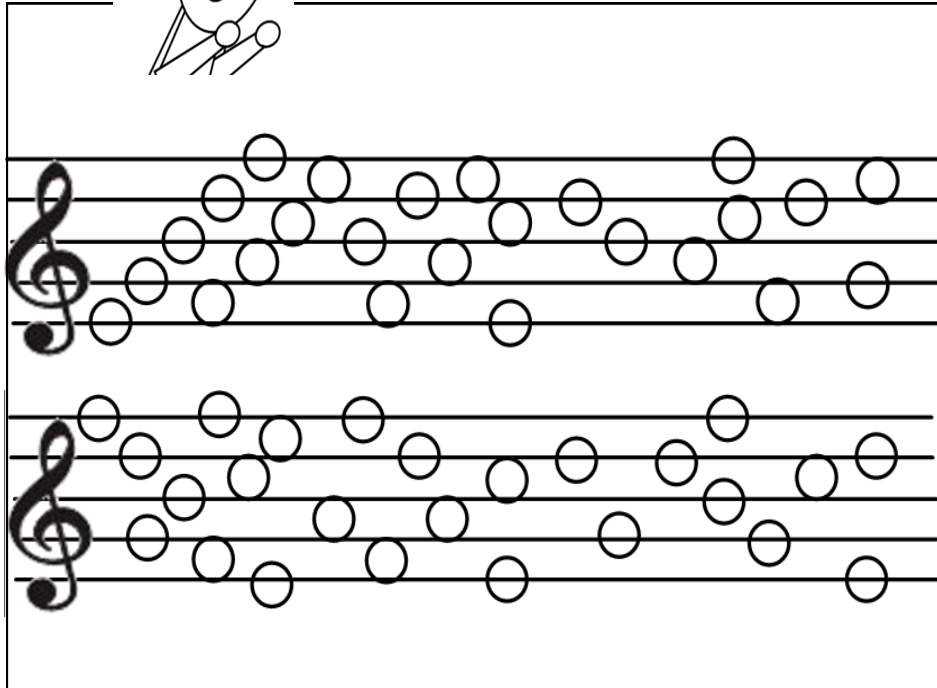

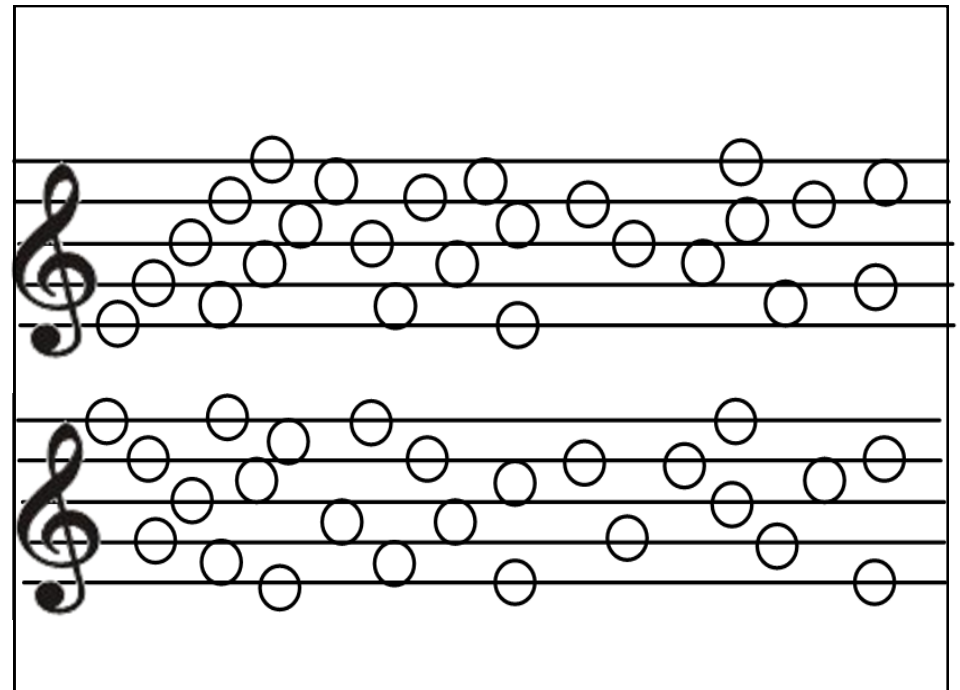
